## Family Doctor

**Hours of operation:** Monday–Friday during the day.  
The hours of operation vary depending on the practice

My first point of contact for health problems, prescriptions, and sick notes (for school/work).



## After-Hours Pharmacies

**Hours of operation:** Nights, on weekends, and public holidays

I urgently need medication and the pharmacies are closed.



## Patient Service 116 117

**Available:** 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.  
Only available in German

I need advice and support quickly for a health problem, and I am not sure where to turn to.



## After-Hours Clinics

**Hours of operation:** Nights, on weekends, and public holidays

I have a health problem that cannot wait until my doctor's office opens or my family doctor is on vacation.



## Emergency Number 112/ Emergency Room

**Available:** 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

In an emergency, call the emergency number immediately (112) or go to the emergency room (ER).
